



Parking in Karlskrona

Questions and answers about parking in the city in the sea.

Welcome to Karlskrona

Karlskrona is the city in the sea. The city center is on Trossö – an island that there are many different ways to get to.

For those who go by car, there are 3500 parking spaces along the streets and squares. Many of them are regulated by time and fee to create good accessibility in the middle of the day, but during the majority of the day and week it is actually free to park here.

In addition to the 3500 parkings spaces, there are also commercial parking garages that are available to everyone, private parking lots and private parking garages.

What is the easiest way to find a free parking space?

As you approach central Karlskrona, you will see digital signs. They show how many parking spaces are available right now in the four large commercial parking garages on Trossö.

The commercial parking garages are open to everyone and have a total of around 760 spaces. All the parking buildings are directly connected to the shopping center and 800 meters of pedestrian street in the city centre.

There are also parking lots along streets and squares as well as a large number of parking spaces at for example Handelshamnen and Chapmansplan.



What do the parking signs mean?

The parking signs show where you can park, for how long you can park there and which fee applies. Sometimes it's a combination of signs that give you the complete information. Below you find an example of that. Read more about parking rules at karlskrona.se/parking.



Parking is permitted

You may stand here for a maximum of seven consecutive days.

You need to pay the fee on weekdays between 09.00 and 16.00.

The parking place is in a green zone, which means the fee is SEK 5 per hour.

On Fridays parking is prohibited between 08.00 and 10.00. This also applies if the particular Friday is on a holiday or the day before a holiday.

This sign shows which residential zone the parking place is in. It is only relevant for you who have residential parking.

Parking is permitted up to this road sign.

Where can I charge my electric car in Karlskrona?

There are many places for that. To find the nearest charging point – visit the website uppladdning.nu.

How do I pay for parking in Karlskrona?

At Karlskrona municipality's parking places, that is the vast majority along streets and squares, you can choose the way that suits you best.

If you want to pay digitally, you can choose between the apps EasyPark, Parkster and ePARK. You can also pay by card, coin, SMS or voicemail. Instructions are available at the nearest parking machine.

However, pay attention to where you park as private car parks may have different payment methods and prices.

How much does it cost to park in Karlskrona?

It depends on where you park, and what time of day.

The most central parking spaces in Karlskrona are in the red zone. Here it costs SEK 13 per hour between 09.00 and 16.00 on weekdays and 10.00 and 14.00 on Saturdays. A short walk from the city center you find the parking spaces in the green zone. There it costs SEK 5 per hour between 09.00 and 16.00 on weekdays.

That means that it's free of charge during most hours of the week. You can see which zone the parking place is in on the signs. Most shops are open until 18.00 on weekdays and until 16.00 on Saturdays. Some are also open on Sundays.



What do the service times mean?

In order for Karlskrona municipality to be able to keep the city neat and clean, it is forbidden to park in many of the places along the streets and squares between 08.00 and 10.00 one certain day a week. The time is used for cleaning and maintenance. Always pay attention to the signs in the place where you park.
